Windsor Police - Community Services Branch (received by email)

✓ Camp Brombal: Community Services Branch will be holding their annual 'Hot Dog Day' in front of headquarters (150 Goyeau) on Friday June 26th from 11 am-2 pm. ALL proceeds benefit their 'Camp Brombal' program.

Multicultural Centre (MCC)

- ✓ A new NP has been recruited to start mid June.
- ✓ A partnership has been established CMHA
- ✓ This weekend is Carousel on the River
- ✓ June 11 – workshop series start designed for health care professionals on Cultural Competence

Leamington Family Health Team

✓ Speak Up Campaign - Advance Care Planning classes held for senior patients aged 75+ or with severe comorbidities to prepare patients and families for end of life.

There have been tailored classes held with the First Nations. It has been well received by patients and their care givers.

CCAC

- ✓ Clients with chronic and high complex needs are the focus.
- ✓ Low or mild needs clients will be community navigated.
- ✓ Streamlining nursing services to have clients come to clinic rather than in home care.
- ✓ Reducing duplicate services.

Community Living Windsor Essex

- ✓ Offering training Trauma and Neuroplasticity in July. Spots have been reserved for community partners. Information regarding this will be emailed to the Committee.

Homeless Coalition

- ✓ Homelessness Challenge held at the end of April. Simulated a day in life of a homeless person attending by over 150 high school students.
- ✓ Housing First pilot has been launched. Press release June 11. Family Services is the lead.
- ✓ Point and Time Count will be at the end of January 2016. Still waiting for funding confirmation.

Windsor Family Health Team

- ✓ Rainbow Health Ontario (August 10-11) will provide transgender training for health care providers. An email will be sent once finalized. This will be available to community partners.
- ✓ One physician still enrolling patients until the end of this year.
- ✓ Six primary care agencies partnering with Health Unit to work on a standardized Healthy Weight Program. This will be offered in Windsor, Essex, Belle River, and Harrow throughout the year.

Erie St. Clair LHIN

- ✓ Rehabilitative Care Committee is approaching year 3 of their strategic plan. The new planning will be hospital focused around hip fractures, stroke and total joint replacement due to ministry funding. Working groups have been established to implement.
- ✓ There will be new definitions for bed levels / numbers.
- ✓ Senior Strategy – assess and restorative framework for frail elderly patients to recognize functional decline and intervene earlier for restorative potential. Assess and restore guidelines have been developed (on ministry website) and a plan to implement the guideline is being worked on. The Provincial Task Team is developing a plan.
- ✓ Looking to rehabilitate patients in the community rather than in hospital when possible. Care pathway has been established.
- ✓ Working on updating the inventory of community rehab outpatient programs.

W5 (Windsor Women Working with Immigrant Women)

- ✓ Moved recently – Open House will be held at 1368 Ouellette in the near future.
- ✓ Women's Groups have been successful – partnership with YMCA averaging 80 women per group.
- ✓ Women's Mental Health Groups are being held in Windsor and the county.
- ✓ Investing in Women's Future Program – life skills and computer training classes held by Scholastica for women held daily and open to all. Information was distributed.

City Centre

- ✓ Successfully completed accreditation
- ✓ Recruiting a part time physician

Mental Health Connections

- ✓ Closing for a week in June to expand facilities
- ✓ Current activities were distributed (attached to the minutes)

WEHC

- ✓ WEHC will be involved in the planning phase for the Leamington Area Obstetrical Navigation Centre to service low speaking German Mennonite population in the area. This will be for the low risk pregnancies. The deliveries will happen in the hospital but all other care will take place outside at the Navigation Centre. All high risk pregnancies will continue to go to Windsor.
- ✓ AGM will be held on June 24 at east end location at Pickwick Plaza (3280 Tecumseh Road).
- ✓ Pickwick Plaza site – primary care with NPs transitioning clients from MCC and chronic disease programs.
- ✓ Accreditation will be held in September.
- ✓ Kids Day will be held on June 17 – contact Street Health for further details (location TBD).
- ✓ Migrant Worker Fair in Leamington in May resulted in 78 new clients at the Leamington site.
- ✓ Rita Taillefer, Director Clinical Services, was recognized as she moves onto her new position with CCAC.

- ✓ Completed a tool kit with both School Boards and will be doing further research in the fall.
