We operate 5 physical locations in Windsor and Essex County. In addition, we have mobile teams providing services throughout Windsor and Essex County. Our programs are funded by both Ministry of Health and Ontario Health, allowing us to offer programs and services at no cost.

Time Commitment

Directors on the Board make a commitment to serve a one(1) - three (3) year term, for a maximum of two terms (6 years). weCHC is a governance volunteer board with a monthly time commitment of approximately 2-4 hours a month. There are no meetings in July & August, unless an emergent Board situation arises. The time commitment includes:

- * Attending bi-monthly board meetings (fourth Wednesday of every month from 5:30-8:00 pm);
- * Participation in a minimum of one sub-committee who meet bi-monthly for 1-2 hours (virtual); and
- * Contribution to task groups and/or other board-related work as needed.
